


Thanks to your support, 2023 marks our biggest impact on people battling cancer since the start of our Grant Program in 2011. Grants increased by 49%, and we reached more patients than ever — a 70% jump from last year. Plus, 91% of patients we surveyed said our program significantly reduced their financial stress during their cancer journey. This feedback underscores the tangible impact of our initiatives. We are not just numbers; our program is changing lives by helping people with basic living essentials while they undergo cancer treatments. Since almost all funds raised are being directed towards the Grant Program, we are able to maximize the impact of every donation, fostering well-being and alleviating burdens for individuals navigating the challenges of cancer treatment and recovery.

The inaugural Cures for the Colors Gala made its debut in 2023, providing a charming evening and a chance to win the reverse raffle. The Cures for the Colors Color Run prevailed in spite of a tropical storm. We also had the honor of hosting the exhibit hall at two Medical Symposiums, fostering collaboration and awareness within the medical community. These events contributed significantly to our fundraising goals while also educating the community about our program and the resources available to people with cancer.
